Please note COVID-19 outbreaks and cases are continuously validated/updated on Ireland's National Computerised Infectious Disease Reporting System (CIDR).

Due to the cyber-attack on the HSE IT systems on 14/05/2021, CIDR was unavailable for the reporting of COVID-19 outbreaks from 14/05/2021 to the 28/06/2021. As a result, there has been a delay in reporting for many outbreaks on CIDR. To account for this, outbreak week for all outbreaks created between May 14th and October 9th is based on the following algorithm: earliest of 1. outbreak recognition date; 2. first reported date; 3. outbreak created date. Outbreak week is based on outbreak created date for all outbreaks created on or before May 13th 2021, and on or after October 10th 2021.

Sincere thanks are extended to all those who are participating in the collection of data and reporting of data used in these reports. This includes the HSE COVID-19 Contact Management Programme (CMP), staff in ICU units, notifying clinicians, laboratory staff, public health doctors, nurses, surveillance scientists, microbiologists and administrative staff.

Summary (Week 26 2021 to Week 48 2021)

3,692 COVID-19 outbreaks have been reported from Week 26 2021 onwards (week beginning 27/06/2021; fourth wave of COVID-19 infection in Ireland) and key outbreak locations are as follows:

- 179 (4.9%) were reported in hospitals
- 149 (4%) were reported in nursing homes
- 31 (0.8%) were reported in community hospital/long-stay units
- 252 (6.8%) were reported in residential institutions
- 110 (3%) were reported in 'other' healthcare services
- 441 (11.9%) were reported in schools#
- 231 (6.3%) were reported in childcare facilities
- 447 (12.1%) were reported in workplaces
- 1,852 (50.3%) were reported in a range of other settings*, including private houses (n=886, 24%), retail outlets (n=151, 4.1%) and social gatherings (n=117, 3.2%). See Table 1 for further details

2,438 outbreaks have been closed and 1,254 outbreaks are open (415 private house outbreaks and 839 outbreaks in all other locations) (See Appendix 1, Table A for breakdown of outbreaks by location and outbreak status. Note that it is common practice not to close private house outbreaks on CIDR due to the large volume of outbreaks in this category).




Figure 1: Epi-curve of COVID-19 outbreaks in all settings notified in Ireland by week of notification and outbreak type (see technical note 5, Appendix 2) to midnight on 04/12/2021, N=21,067 Data source: CIDR

21,067 COVID-19 outbreaks have been reported in Ireland since week 10, 2020 (Figure 1).

Summary (Week 48, 2021)

In Week 48 2021, there were 139 COVID-19 outbreaks notified:

- The overall number of outbreaks notified in Week 48 decreased by 12 compared to Week 47 2021
- There were 10 acute hospital outbreaks notified
- There were 10 nursing home outbreaks notified
- There were five community hospital/long-stay unit outbreaks notified
- There were 26 residential institution outbreaks notified
- There were 10 outbreaks associated with other healthcare services notified
- There were 30 outbreaks associated with schools notified
- There were eight outbreaks associated with childcare facilities notified
- There were seven outbreaks associated with workplaces notified (see Table 10 for further details)
- There was a one travel-related outbreak which included one confirmed VOC Omicron case
- The remaining 32 outbreaks* included private houses (n=26), extended family (n=3), sporting activity/fitness (n=2), restaurant/café (n=1).

*Regional Departments of Public Health are currently prioritising Public Health Risk Assessments and outbreak investigations in settings that have the greatest clinical need or would benefit most from Public Health intervention. For this reason, outbreaks in some settings may be underestimated in this report. Tables 1, 2A and 2B focus on these key settings, with the remaining settings coloured grey.

*In Week 44 2021, 32 outbreaks associated with schools that occurred during May and June 2021 (2020/21 academic year) were retrospectively notified.







COVID-19 Outbreaks/Clusters in Residential Facilities and Hospital settings in Ireland




Figure 2 A-D: Epi-curve of COVID-19 outbreaks in (A) Acute Hospitals, (B) Nursing Homes, (C) Community Hospitals/Long-stay units and (D) Residential institutions notified in Ireland by week of notification, from 27/06/2021 to midnight on 04/12/2021. Data source: CIDR

A summary of COVID-19 outbreaks linked to nursing homes, acute hospitals, community hospital/long-stay units, and other residential institutions is shown in Figure 2 (A-D), in the subsequent "Focus" sections and Tables 3-7.

Focus on Nursing Homes and Community Hospitals

There have been **829** COVID-19 outbreaks in nursing homes and community hospital/long stay units, with **18,551** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

From 27/06/2021 to 04/12/2021, **180** outbreaks in nursing homes or community hospital/long-stay units have been notified and **71** of these outbreaks remain open. A total of **2,416 laboratory confirmed cases** linked to outbreaks in nursing homes or community hospital/long-stay units have been notified. Of those cases, 183 were hospitalised, <5 were admitted to ICU, and 158 cases died (Table 3).

There were ten new COVID-19 outbreaks reported in nursing homes and five in community hospital/long-term care facilities during Week 48 2021




Figure 3: Epi-curve of confirmed COVID-19 cases linked to outbreaks in nursing homes and community hospital/long-stay units by age group (<65 years and ≥65 years), date of notification, and cumulative number of confirmed cases during the fourth wave of infection from 27/06/2021 to midnight 04/12/2021. *Data source: CIDR*

Focus on Acute Hospitals

There were 603 COVID-19 outbreaks in acute hospitals, with 6,800 linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.




Figure 4: Epi-curve of confirmed COVID-19 cases linked to outbreaks in acute hospitals by healthcare worker (HCW) status and by date of notification, and cumulative number of confirmed cases during the fourth wave of infection by date of notification, from 27/06/2021 to midnight on 04/12/2021. Data source: CIDR

From 27/06/2021 to 04/12/2021, **179** outbreaks in acute hospitals have been notified and **73** of these outbreaks remain open. A total of **971** laboratory confirmed cases linked to outbreaks in acute hospitals have been notified. Of those, 18 were admitted to ICU and 85 died (Table 5). Cases were reported to be a healthcare worker (HCW) in 274 cases, not a HCW in 445 cases and HCW status was unknown for the remaining cases (Figure 4).

There were ten new COVID-19 outbreaks reported in acute hospitals during Week 48 2021

Focus on Residential Institutions (please see footnote¹)

There were 663 COVID-19 outbreaks in residential institutions, with 4,022 linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

From 27/06/2021 to 04/12/2021, **214** outbreaks in residential institutions have been notified and **122** of these outbreaks remain open. There were **891 laboratory confirmed cases** linked to outbreaks in residential institutions. Of those, **29** cases were hospitalised, two were admitted to ICU and seven cases died (Table 6). The majority of residential institution outbreaks were notified in centres for disabilities, with **157** outbreaks and **675** confirmed linked cases notified since Week 26 2021.

There were 22 new COVID-19 outbreaks reported in residential institutions in Week 48 2021: 18 in centres for disabilities; three in a Children's/TUSLA residential centre; one in a mental health facility

COVID-19 Outbreaks in Other Healthcare Settings

There were **302** COVID-19 outbreaks associated with other healthcare settings, with **1,102** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

This brief overview of COVID-19 outbreaks in other healthcare settings notified up to midnight on 04/12/2021 (Table 7). Since week 26 2021 there have been **110** outbreaks associated with other healthcare services and **70** of these remain open. There were **285 linked laboratory confirmed cases** associated with other healthcare service outbreaks.

There were ten new COVID-19 outbreaks reported in other healthcare settings in Week 48 2021: six associated with services for people with disabilities, three associated with home care services and one in other healthcare services.

COVID-19 Outbreaks in Other Vulnerable Populations

There were **843** COVID-19 outbreaks associated with the below described vulnerable populations, with **7,990** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

This brief overview of COVID-19 outbreaks in vulnerable populations/settings only includes outbreaks involving Irish Travellers, the Roma community, outbreaks in Direct Provision Centres, facilities for the homeless/those with addiction issues and prisons notified up to midnight on 04/12/2021 (Table 8). From 27/06/2021 to 04/12/2021, there have been **243** outbreaks in vulnerable populations, of which 130 remain open. There were **1,423 linked laboratory confirmed cases** associated with outbreaks in vulnerable groups in this time period.

There were seven new outbreaks reported in vulnerable populations during Week 48 2021:

- Three outbreaks among Irish Travellers
- Four outbreaks related to a Direct Provision Centre

COVID-19 Outbreaks associated with school children (+/- staff), universities/colleges and childcare facilities

There were **1,220** COVID-19 outbreaks in schools, with **6,226** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases; **219** outbreaks in universities colleges/third-level students, with **2,414** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases; **628** outbreaks in childcare facilities, with **3,352** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

In total, **687** COVID-19 outbreaks associated with school children (+/- staff), universities/colleges/third level students and childcare facilities have been notified from 27/06/2021 up to midnight on 04/12/2021 (Table 9) and 209 of these outbreaks remain open.

During Week 48 2021, there were 30 COVID-19 outbreaks notified associated with school children +/- staff, and there were eight COVID-19 outbreaks associated with childcare facilities

COVID-19 Outbreaks associated with Workplaces

There were **1,236** COVID-19 outbreaks in workplaces, with **8,873** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases; **135** outbreaks in meat/poultry production and processing facilities, with **3,616** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases and **149** outbreaks in other food/beverage production and processing facilities, with **1,301** linked laboratory confirmed COVID-19 cases, notified in Ireland since 01/03/2020.

In total, **447** COVID-19 outbreaks associated with workplaces have been notified from 27/06/2021 up to midnight on 04/12/2021 (Table 10) and 95 of these outbreaks remain open.

During **Week 48** 2021, there were **seven** COVID-19 outbreaks notified associated with workplaces; **one** in a meat/poultry production and processing facility; **two** in other food/beverage production and processing and; four in a variety of other workplace settings including construction (n=2), commercial (n=1) and office (n=1).

Appendix 2 Technical Notes

- 1. Data are based on statutory notifications and were extracted from the National Computerised Infectious Disease Reporting (CIDR) system. Data are provisional and subject to ongoing review, validation and update. As a result, figures in this report may differ from previously published figures.
- For surveillance purposes, the following COVID-19 outbreak definition is used for notifying COVID-19 outbreaks/clusters:
 Confirmed*
 - There is a cluster/outbreak, with two or more cases of laboratory confirmed COVID-19 infection regardless of symptom status. This includes cases with symptoms and cases who are asymptomatic.
 OR
 - There is a cluster/outbreak, with two or more cases of illness with symptoms consistent
 with COVID-19 infection (as per the COVID-19 case definition), and at least one person is a
 confirmed case of COVID-19.

* From September 21st 2020, suspected COVID outbreaks should be reported with the disease category 'Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI)'. If one or more cases linked to the outbreak are subsequently confirmed as COVID-19, the ARI outbreak should be reclassified to being a COVID-19 outbreak. Outbreaks of suspected COVID-19 which were notified before September 21st 2020, and met the previous COVID-19 outbreak definition should remain as COVID-19 outbreaks on CIDR.

- 3. This report includes confirmed and suspected COVID-19 outbreaks.
- 4. An "Open" or "Closed" outbreak is defined as an outbreak where the outbreak status is "Open" or "Closed" on CIDR. In order to declare an outbreak "Closed" the outbreak location should not have experienced any new cases of infection which meet the case definition for a period of 28 days (two incubation periods).
- 5. Outbreak type (family/general) indicates whether an outbreak is confined to a family (family outbreak) or affects members of more than one household (general outbreak).
- 6. The "range in number of cases" presented in Tables 3, 5, and 6-9 is based on laboratory confirmed cases linked to an outbreak in CIDR. The priority is to notify outbreaks to CIDR in a timely fashion and, while every effort is made to link cases to outbreaks as quickly as possible, there can sometimes be a delay in linking cases to the outbreak. Ranges in number of cases that include "0" include outbreaks that currently have no linked cases. Data in CIDR are continuously reviewed and updated and this includes the identification and linking of outbreak-associated cases.
